The MayFly Flag - LIMERICK TO NEW YORK

Artists Deirdre Power & Chelsea Canavan are delighted to have our 'Mayfly Flag' selected for The Flag Project 2022 at Rockefeller Center supported by The Climate Museum and the UN Environment Programme

Commissioned for the Eco Showboat, the design reflects the short lived aquatic insect of the northern hemisphere, the ephemeral Mayfly. We will present messages from Limerick Citizens in NY through semaphore postcards – a celebration of the ecology of the community from citizens young and old of Limerick City, acknowledging their dedication to ecological preservation.

The flag design will be celebrated in Limerick City & New York during RiverFest 2022.
